The **School-to-Careers Partnership of Broome and Tioga Counties** is pleased to announce that through the generous support of **Lockheed Martin** grant funds are available to support a limited number of programs targeting elementary, middle and high school students in the Broome and Tioga County school districts served by Broome-Tioga BOCES. These grants will help the region meet the objectives of the newly formed **STEM Hub of the Eastern Southern Tier NY.**

STEM Hub Mission:

- **INFORM** engage and excite students in Science, Technology, Engineering and/or Math;
- **INSPIRE** and encourage students to enroll in challenging STEM courses at the high school level and beyond;
- **EDUCATE** and prepare a more diverse group of students to participate in STEM by providing support to populations under-represented in the STEM field; and
- **CONNECT** and support STEM college and career readiness initiatives and academic enrichment
 - **Proposals must reflect the potential of the proposed project to clearly support the mission listed above.**

Available Funding

Grant requests may be made in three categories based on the funds requested and the scope of the project:

- \$1,000 or less – Small projects with a specific targeted service population and relatively short duration.
- \$1,001 to \$5,000 – Larger scale projects that reach a larger service population, are longer in duration, and will involve multiple schools, districts, and/or community organizations.
- \$5,000 to \$10,000 – Expected to have regional scope involving multiple partners
- ***\$10,000 is the maximum amount for each request***
Applicants are highly encouraged to engage community organizations to create high impact programs by leveraging other resources, both financial and programmatic.

How to Apply

All applicants must complete and submit the **STEM Hub of the Eastern Southern Tier – STEM Hub Grant Application.** Incomplete applications will not be considered for funding. *Grant requests submitted after the deadline will be reviewed on a case by case basis.* If awarded this monetary grant we will be requesting both an interim and final report.
